Then, you will visit the Floating **Village (Tonle Sap)**. The Tonle Sap Lake, fed by the mighty Menkong and the Tonle Sap River, is a vast expanse of water that forms the most significant topographical feature in Cambodia. And enjoy shopping around the Old **Market**. Lunch and Dinner with apsara dance show restaurant. Overnight in Siem Reap.


